

# RULES FOR VISITOR'S AT THE KELTENWELT AM GLAUBERG



We would like to welcome you to the Archaeological Museum Keltenwelt am Glauberg (KWG), an institution of the State Heritage Office of Hesse, and wish you an enjoyable and interesting visit. The rules for visitors are intended to make your stay at the Museum and Archaeological Park and the Museum Bistro as pleasant as possible, and are binding for all visitors.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### Photography and filming

Photography and filming are generally permitted in the Museum and the Archaeological Park for private purposes. The use of additional artificial light (flash) and of tripods or similar aids is not permitted. Photography and filming for professional and commercial purposes indoors and outdoors require written permission from KWG. The use of drones is generally only permitted with the prior approval of KWG.

### Guided tours and programmes for visitors

Commercial tours and programmes are not permitted in the museum or outdoor areas. Permission is granted by KWG.

### Rules of conduct

Visitors are obliged to behave in such a way that other persons are not hindered, harassed or endangered, and that museum objects and other facilities at the site are not damaged.

It is forbidden for visitors to use words, writing or gestures that are contemptuous of human freedom and dignity (Article 1 of the Constitution), or to use signs and symbols that are in the spirit of or represent anti-constitutional or unconstitutional organisations.

Wearing or carrying historical clothing and equipment, in particular weapons of any kind, is not permitted.

Animals may not be taken into the exhibition rooms (assistance and guide dogs are welcome!). Dogs must be kept on a leash in the outdoor areas, museum garden and bistro.

### Orders for special situations and exclusion orders

The museum staff is entitled to issue orders in the interest of KWG. These must be obeyed. Failure to comply with the house rules may result in being banned from the premises. In the event of such a ban, admission fees will not be refunded.

### Liability

The agency is only liable in cases of intent and gross negligence. Visitors are liable for any damage caused by them in accordance with the statutory provisions.

## MUSEUM, MUSEUM GARDEN AND BISTRO

The museum and the museum garden can be visited during opening hours, although individual areas may be temporarily closed (e.g. during construction work or due to weather conditions).

When visiting in groups, accompanying persons are instructed to stay with their group and keep the group together. Guided tours of the museum and its grounds may be terminated by the tour guide if problems with the group staying together become apparent, in spite of requests that the group do so. In this case, there is no entitlement to reimbursement of the costs of the tour.

The demonstration of historical handicraft and production techniques can be dangerous.

The consumption of food and drinks brought to the site is not permitted.

The toilets are only available to guests of KWG and the bistro. Smoking (including e-cigarettes) is not permitted in the museum building.

KWG accepts no liability for the cloakroom or the contents of the lockers.

## ARCHAEOLOGICAL PARK AND PARKING

The Archaeological Park is freely accessible. The grounds may only be used during daylight hours and at visitors' own risk. Leaving the paths is not permitted. No liability is accepted for injuries, damaged clothing or other objects. It is not permitted to stay on the site during storms or when severe weather threatens. The demonstration of historical crafts and production techniques can be dangerous. Vehicles of any kind, bicycles and motorbikes are not permitted on the Glauberg Plateau; this also applies to riding animals.

Most of the paths in the open-air grounds are unpaved. They are not barrier-free. Pay particular attention to uneven ground such as stones, branches, and molehills and holes in the car park, paths, meadows and grassy areas. Insufficient light and uneven ground call for particular attention. There is a danger of falling. For design reasons, not all danger spots are indicated by warning signs. During the winter months there is an increased risk of accidents in the Archaeological Park and the car park due to snow and ice.

Open fires (e.g. barbecues, campfires, flares, candles) are not permitted in the Archaeological Park and the car park. Do not throw away burning cigarette ends or objects such as glass, as these may cause fires.

Standard road traffic regulations apply in the car park. No long-term parking; parking for more than 24 hours is not permitted.

The KWG is a site on the grounds of a legally protected archaeological monument and landscape conservation area. Any interference with the soil and exposed archaeological remains is strictly prohibited. We maintain high ecological standards. Please support us in this endeavour.

Offering goods for sale and the setting up of sales stands of any kind, visitor surveys and the distribution of brochures are only permitted in the outdoor area of KWG with express, written permission.
