

VISITING REGULATIONS FOR THE KELTENWELT AM GLAUBERG

We warmly welcome you to the Archaeological State Museum Keltenwelt am Glauberg (KWG), an institution of the Hessian State Office for the Preservation of Historical Monuments, and wish you a pleasant and interesting stay. The visitor regulations are designed to make your visit to the museum and archaeological park, as well as the museum bistro, as enjoyable as possible and are binding for all guests.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Photography and filming

Photography and filming are generally allowed for private purposes in the museum and the Archaeological Park. The use of additional artificial light (flash) and of tripods or similar aids is not permitted. Photography and filming for professional and commercial purposes, both indoors and outdoors, require written permission from KWG. The use of drones is generally allowed only after prior approval from KWG.

Guided tours and visitor programs

Commercial tours and programs in the museum and outdoor areas are not allowed. Permissions are granted by KWG.

Rules of behavior

Visitors are obligated to behave in a manner that does not obstruct, harass, or endanger other individuals and does not damage museum objects and other facilities within the premises.

Visitors are prohibited from making contemptuous remarks, in word, writing, or gesture, about the freedom and dignity of individuals (Article 1 of the German Basic Law) and from using symbols and signs associated with extremist or unconstitutional organizations or representing them.

Wearing historical costumes and equipment, especially carrying any type of weapons, is not allowed.

Animals are not allowed in the exhibition (assistance and guide dogs are welcome!). In the outdoor area, museum garden, and bistro, dogs must be kept on a leash.

Order for individual cases and house ban

The museum staff has the authority to issue directives in the interest of KWG. Visitors are required to comply with these directives. Failure to adhere to this house rule may result in an entry ban for the premises. In the event of an entry ban, the admission fee will not be refunded.

Liability



Liability on the part of the venue operator is only possible in cases of intent and gross negligence. Visitors are liable for any damage they cause in accordance with the statutory provisions.

MUSEUM, MUSEUM GARDEN AND BISTRO

The museum and museum garden can be visited during opening hours, although specific areas may be temporarily closed (e.g., during construction work or adverse weather conditions). Please adhere to the *garden rules*.

When visiting in groups, accompanying persons are instructed to stay with their group and keep the group together. A guided tour of the museum and outdoor areas may be terminated by the guide if, even after instructions, it is unlikely that the group can be kept together. In such cases, there is no entitlement to a refund of the tour costs.

Demonstrations of historical crafts and production techniques may involve risks.

Consuming brought food and drinks is not allowed. Restrooms are only available to KWG and bistro guests. Smoking (including e-cigarettes) is not permitted in the museum building.

KWG assumes no liability for the cloakroom and the contents of the lockers.

ARCHAEOLOGICAL PARK AND PARKING LOTS

The Archaeological Park is freely accessible. The grounds may only be used during daylight hours and at your own risk. Leaving the paths is not allowed. KWG assumes no liability for injuries, damaged clothing, and other items. Stay is not permitted in stormy or inclement weather. Demonstrations of historical crafts and production techniques may involve risks.

On the Glauberg plateau, vehicles of all kinds, bicycles, and motorcycles are not allowed; this also applies to riding animals. The paths in the open-air area are mostly unpaved and not wheelchair-accessible. Pay attention, especially in the parking lot, on paths, meadows, and green areas, to uneven surfaces such as stones, branches, and molehills. Inadequate lighting and uneven ground require special caution. There is a risk of falling. Not all danger points are marked by warning signs for design reasons. During the winter months, there is an increased risk of accidents due to snow and ice in the Archaeological Park and on the parking lots.

Open fires (e.g., grills, bonfires, torches, candles) are not allowed in the Archaeological Park and on the parking lots. Do not throw burning cigarette butts and items like glass, as this can cause a fire.

Traffic rules apply in the parking lot. No permanent parking; parking for more than 24 hours is not allowed.

KWG is a facility on the grounds of a legally protected archaeological site and a landscape conservation area. Any interference with the soil and exposed archaeological remains is strictly prohibited. We have a high ecological standard. Please support us in this effort.



The offering of goods and the setup of sales booths of any kind, visitor surveys, and brochure distributions are only permitted in the outdoor area of KWG with explicit written permission.
